

Kentucky Engineering Abroad – Pamplona, Spain

CME 599 – Renewable Energies

The University of Kentucky College of Engineering, in collaboration with the Pamplona Learning Spanish Institute, is pleased to sponsor an inaugural education abroad program to Pamplona, Spain for Summer 2010. Students may choose from two unique learning opportunities. Option A is a two-week course covering general Spanish and Spanish for Engineering. Option B incorporates the two-week general Spanish course as well as a four-week course on Renewable Energies. Included in Option B will be on-site visits to four renewable energy generation sites in the Navarre region which boasts 70% energy generation from renewable sources. Prior knowledge of the Spanish language is not required to participate in this exciting learning abroad opportunity.



In the heart of the Navarre region of Spain, the Pamplona Learning Spanish Institute is located in the center of the city of Pamplona. Students will have easy access to public transportation, museums, historic cathedrals and churches, and numerous parks. Pamplona is most famous throughout the world for San Fermine's, the Running of the Bulls, an event dating back to medieval times.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Class Information: This University of Kentucky-sponsored course is organized by Pamplona Learning Spanish Institute in conjunction with the Association of Industrial Engineers of Navarre, in Pamplona, Spain. The specialized program on renewable energy will provide students with advanced knowledge of the energy sector, with a focus on renewable energy. The Navarre region of Spain is a leader in the use of renewable energy with 70% generated from renewable sources. The course includes four field trips to renewable energy facilities in the region.

Credit Hours: Students will receive four credit hours for the course.

Spanish Proficiency: Prior knowledge of Spanish is not required as the engineering portion of the course is offered in English.

Class Registration:

UK Students: Current University of Kentucky students should register for CME 599 – Renewable Energy for Summer Session II during UK pre-registration.

Non-UK Students: Students from other U.S. universities will need to apply to the University of Kentucky as a visiting student by accessing <http://www.uky.edu/Admission/visiting.htm>. Once visiting status is granted, the student will register for CME 599 – Renewable Energy for Summer Session II.

Program Fee includes tuition, fees, travel medical insurance, lodging, course-related field trips and cultural visits.

Lodging Options include either a shared apartment or home stay with a local family from the Sunday prior to the start of classes through the Saturday following the last day of class.

- Shared Apartment includes bed linens, blankets and towels, access to fully equipped kitchen and laundry, cleaning of common rooms, utilities (electricity, gas and water) up to certain expense. Excess charges will be charged to the student.
- Family Stay includes continental breakfast and dinner, Monday through Friday, and continental breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and Sunday.

Transfer service from the Pamplona airport, train or bus station to accommodation: 35€.

Airline tickets, passport fees, and personal expenses are the responsibility of the student.

Attach \$50 in cash, check or money order made payable to the University of Kentucky.
