**Dr. Bamin Khomami** has been named the **Armour T. Granger and Alvin & Sally Beaman Professor and Head of the Department of Chemical Engineering at the University of Tennessee's College of Engineering.**

Khomami was previously the Francis F. Ahmann Professor of Chemical Engineering at Washington University (WU) in St. Louis. In 1987, he joined the WU faculty as an assistant professor after obtaining his Ph.D. in chemical engineering from the University of Illinois in Urbana.

Khomami's research activities primarily deal with engineering of materials with a desired micro- or nano-structure in addition to the application of nanotechnology including large scale integrated nano/micro fluidic devices to biology, chemistry and medicine. His research has resulted in more than 100 refereed journal publications as well as many presentations at national and international meetings.

In addition, Khomami is listed in *Who's is Who in American Science and Engineering* and *Who's Who in the World of Science and Engineering*. He serves on a number of journal editorial boards and international steering and award committees.
