Dr. C.T. Liu has been appointed as a **Distinguished Research Professor** at the University of Tennessee College of Engineering's Department of Materials Science and Engineering.

Liu is a world authority in the field of structural intermetallics, recognized for advancing ordered metallic compounds from the laboratory to practice.

The extensive research conducted by Liu has garnered him numerous honors including the 2001 Acta Metallurgical Gold Award; a Distinguished Inventor of the Battelle Memorial Institute recognition; and designation as one of the "1,000 Most Cited Physicists" from 1981 to 1997.

Liu was employed with Oak Ridge National Laboratory from 1967 to 2003 as a group leader in the Metals and Ceramics Division. He is an elected member of the elite National Academy of Engineering, a foreign member of the Chinese Academy of Engineering and Fellow of the World Technology Network.

Liu received his B.S. in mechanical engineering from National Taiwan University and his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from Brown University.
